1. Background

1.1 St Austell Town Council submitted an application for a capital grant from the PCC to support the cost of purchasing a mobile CCTV camera for use in the town.

2. Decision record

2.1 The OPCC will award £2,735 to St Austell Town Council for the total cost of the redeployable, mobile CCTV camera in St Austell. This amounts to 30% of costs.

3. Consultation, engagement and communication

3.1 The local police Inspector for St Austell has been consulted as part of this application and is fully supportive of the proposal. Safer St Austell, a subgroup of Safer Cornwall, also supports the proposal.

4. OPCC Monitoring Officer advice

4.1 Legal, Management and Equality Implications – Current and Future

The PCC's Chief Executive and Monitoring Officer has advised that the arrangements set out in the proposal meet the requirements of the PCC's CCTV Investment Strategy and the criteria for awarding capital grants.
