1. Background

- 1.1. The Police and Crime Commissioner agreed £5,000 funding for Keyham NHW to carry out works under the DaCCWA Feel Safe Scheme in the aftermath of the mass shootings in August 2021.
- 1.2. In September 2021, the Commissioner agreed an additional £4,000 towards the neighbourhood watch in Keyham, bringing the funding under the DaCCWA Scheme to £9,000 in total.

2. Decision Record

- 2.1 To provide additional funding for a total of £9,000 towards the DaCCWA Feel Safe Scheme in Keyham.

3. Consultation, Engagement and Communication

- 3.1 This funding was approved by the Police and Crime Commissioner in response to the mass shootings in Plymouth. The funding was agreed in consultation with the Treasurer of the OPCC.

4. OPCC Monitoring Officer advice

- 4.1 The OPCC's Chief Executive and Monitoring Officer has advised that the arrangements set out in the proposal meet the requirements of the relevant legislation and the needs of the organisation.

The OPCC's CEO and Monitoring Officer has advised that this decision is within the powers of those making it and that, from the information provided, there would not appear to be any adverse legal, managerial, equality or GDPR implications arising from the proposal.

EDHR obligations have been considered when taking this decision and on this occasion it is not necessary to complete an Equality Impact Assessment. The decision will not impact on human resources, equality or diversity obligations.

Chief Finance Officer and S151 Officer has advised that the expenditure incurred by this decision is consistent with the financial priorities and role of the PCC.
