1.0 BACKGROUND

- 1.1 *To support the road safety strategy the PCC has been working closely with the Honest Truth charity to work with driving instructors to educate student drivers to consider the dangerous behaviours that may put them, their passengers and other road users at risk.*
- 1.2 *The OPCC has provided support to the Honest Truth by paying for a promotional campaign utilising local buses to carry the charity's distinctive imagery. The OPCC has also facilitated a north Devon-based haulage firm, Evans Transport, to provide free space on their truck fleet to carry the Honest Truth's campaign imagery.*
- 1.3 *This decision relates to a further application from the Honest Truth to support them by meeting the costs of materials to help promote this campaign. The literature will be provided to driving instructors to engage directly with pupils whilst learning.*

2.0 DECISION RECORD

- 2.1 *To provide £1100 to the Honest Truth for the provision of leaflets, postcards, flag and pull up banners, posters, pledge cards for supply to approved driving instructors to pass on to learner drivers in support of the HT campaign.*

3.0 CONSULTATION, ENGAGEMENT AND COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 *The Honest Truth vehicle backs campaign has been jointly funded and planned by the OPCC and the North Devon and Torridge CSP.*

4.0 OPCC MONITORING OFFICER ADVICE

4.1 Legal, Management and Equality Implications – Current and Future

The PCC's CEO and Monitoring Officer has advised that this decision is within the powers of the PCC to make. There are no adverse legal, management and equality issues arising from this proposal.


