1.0 BACKGROUND

- 1.1 Cornwall Fire Service submitted an application for a capital grant from the PCC to support the cost of increasing the capacity of the Critical Control Room at Tolvaddon Fire Station. This will enable the Fire Service to offer monitoring services to more towns in Cornwall.
- 1.2 David Eaton discussed the application in detail with Kevin Thomas, Assistant Chief Fire Officer, and subsequently presented a report to OPCC Management Board.

2.0 DECISION RECORD

2.1 The OPCC will award a £30,000 grant to Cornwall Council towards the total cost of extending the Fire Service control room.

3.0 CONSULTATION, ENGAGEMENT AND COMMUNICATION

3.1 Following an assessment of the number of towns in Cornwall which were preparing funding applications for capital grants from the PCC, the PCC was assured that the expanded capacity at Tolvaddon was necessary to meet the needs of those towns which were progressing through the funding application process.

4.0 OPCC MONITORING OFFICER ADVICE

4.1 Legal, Management and Equality Implications – Current and Future

The PCC's Chief Executive and Monitoring Officer has advised that the arrangements set out in the proposal meet the requirements of the PCC's CCTV Investment Strategy and the criteria for awarding capital grants.

The PCC's CEO and Monitoring Officer has advised that this decision is within the powers of those making it and that, from the information provided, there would not appear to be any adverse legal, managerial or equality implications arising from the proposal.

The grant awarded is no more than 30% of the capital cost of the works.



4.2 Financial and Commercial – Current and Future

The PCC's Chief Finance Officer and S151 Officer has advised that the financial requirements of this Decision are consistent with the criteria of the CCTV Investment Strategy and delivers against the PCC's Police and Crime Plan priorities.
