REPORT OF THE DEVON AND CORNWALL POLICE AND CRIME PANEL

I. Purpose of Report

The purpose of this report is to set out the Devon and Cornwall Police and Crime Panel's formal response to items considered at its meeting held on 2 February 2024.

The Police and Crime Commissioner has a statutory requirement to set an annual Police and Crime budget and, as part of that process, to consult with the Police and Crime Panel regarding any proposals in relation to the council tax precept.

At the meeting of the Police and Crime Panel on 2 February 2024, the Police and Crime Commissioner set out her proposed precept for 2024/25 and the Medium Term Financial Strategy for 2024/25 to 2027/28.

2. 2023/24 Precept Notification

The Devon and Cornwall Police and Crime Panel resolved to accept the council tax precept proposal and not exercise a veto.

The Panel asked the Commissioner to consider potential governance arrangements to ensure political oversight on the allocation of resources from Grants.
