1. BACKGROUND

1.1 Plymouth City Council submitted an application for a capital grant from the PCC to support the cost of installing a CCTV cameras on Plymouth Hoe.

2. DECISION RECORD

2.1 The OPCC will award £19,400 to Plymouth City Council for the total cost of the permanent solution for a CCTV camera installation on Plymouth Hoe, plus £2,185 for a rapid deployment camera. This amounts to 50% of both the costs.

3. CONSULTATION, ENGAGEMENT AND COMMUNICATION

3.1 This was an urgent decision necessitated by local circumstances and events with the agreement of the OPCC Chief Executive and Plymouth City Council.

4. OPCC MONITORING OFFICER ADVICE

4.1 Legal, Management and Equality Implications – Current and Future

The PCC's Chief Executive and Monitoring Officer has advised that the arrangements set out in the proposal meet the requirements of the PCC's CCTV Investment Strategy and the criteria for awarding capital grants.
