1. Background

- 1.1 Plymouth City Council submitted an application for a capital grant from the PCC to support the cost of installing CCTV equipment in Mutley Plain.

2. Decision record

- 2.1 The OPCC will award £7,500 to Plymouth City Council to invest in a CCTV camera at Mutley Plain.

3. Consultation, engagement and communication

- 3.1 This grant has been given as a special case following an approach from Plymouth City Council for funds to purchase a redeployable CCTV camera for Mutley Plain, Plymouth. The specific location will cover a vulnerable area of the city which has been subject to a significant increase in crime particularly drug dealing and a more serious allegation of sexual assault.

The technology being deployed will be new technology and due to the wireless nature will be re-deployable in the area of Mutley should the focus of crime move.

4. OPCC Monitoring Officer advice

4.1 Legal, Management and Equality Implications – Current and Future

The PCC's acting Monitoring Officer has advised that the arrangements set out in the proposal satisfy the requirements of awarding a capital grant.


