1. Background

- 1.1 Truro City Council submitted an application for a capital grant from the PCC to support the cost of installing additional CCTV equipment on Furniss Island.
- 1.2 Truro City Council submitted a request for funding to the OPCC. The OPCC will support 30% of the costs.

2. Decision record

- 2.1 The OPCC will award £1,967 to Truro City Council towards the total cost of CCTV improvements.

3. Consultation, engagement and communication

- 3.1 Prior to approval of the grant award, the proposal to purchase a CCTV system for Truro was discussed with the local Neighbourhood Beat Manager. This provided assurance that there would be an operational benefit in reducing crime and anti-social behaviour if CCTV cameras were installed on Furniss Island.

4. OPCC Monitoring Officer advice

4.1 Legal, Management and Equality Implications – Current and Future

The PCC's Monitoring Officer has advised that the arrangements set out in the proposal meet the requirements of the PCC's CCTV Investment Strategy and the criteria for awarding capital grants.

The PCC's Monitoring Officer has advised that this decision is within the powers of those making it and that, from the information provided, there would not appear to be any adverse legal, managerial or equality implications arising from the proposal.

The grant awarded is no more than 30% of the total capital cost of the works.

4.2 Financial and Commercial – Current and Future

The PCC's Chief Finance Officer and S151 Officer has advised that the financial requirements of this Decision are consistent with the criteria of the CCTV Investment Strategy and delivers against the PCC's Police and Crime Plan priorities.


