HMICFRS VALUE FOR MONEY PROFILES 2018

REPORT BY NEAL BUTTERWORTH, ALLIANCE HEAD OF FINANCE

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

The purpose of this report is to provide members with an overview of the 2018 Value for Money Profiles relating to Dorset Police and Devon & Cornwall Police.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. Each year the HMICFRS produces information relating to performance and spending of all police forces as 'Value for Money Profiles' (Vfm Profiles). Until 2017 these VfM Profiles were produced as standalone documents for each Force. With effect from 2018, the VfM Profiles were produced as an interactive 'dashboard' on the HMICFRS website.
- 1.2. The VfM Profiles compare each Force with its Most Similar Group of Forces (MSG). The MSG for each Force is shown below


- 1.4. This report sets out key tables for each Force for information using extracts from the HMICFRS website.

2. KEY INFORMATION



As in previous years, the information does not directly provide answers to differences in levels of spend / crime / workforce, but rather provides a basis on which to raise questions. As such, no analysis is provided for the following charts.
- 2.2. The VfM Profiles are used internally to evidence relative spend in business cases and similar, and to provide information on which to challenge spend.




How does spend compare - by POA Objective (net revenue expenditure per population)

● NRE/pop- Force (£) ● NRE/pop- MSG (£) ● NRE PP-AII












2.6. Long Term Spending and Workforce Change




How has staffing changed - long term (FTE per 1,000 po...














2.9. Officer and Staff Levels







2.10. Officer Levels by Rank


