<ul> <li>In December 2015 it was agreed by the Police and Crime Commissioner and the Chief Constable to recognise and agree the requirement for a longer term strategy with regard to volunteers, that will facilitate 'communities in policing' not just 'policing in communities'.</li> <li>It was also agreed to support a 3yr plan of investment to transform the delivery of Citizens in Policing, enabling and encouraging cultural change to enhance connecting communities to policing and policing to communities.</li> <li>At the meeting of the Joint Management Board on 22 March 2016 the draft strategy was approved, with further consultation to take place, including with Dorset police.</li> <li>It was also agreed that there was a need for investment in an infrastructure that will improve retention of existing and future volunteers, and will also enable enhanced recruitment.</li> </ul>
