# 1. Background

1.1 Exeter City Council submitted an application for a capital grant from the PCC to support the cost upgrading the CCTV control hub in the city. The facility will provide a monitoring capability to allow towns across Devon to link in for monitoring service

# 2. Decision Record

2.1 The OPCC will award £80,000 to Exeter City Council for the total cost of the CCTV control room upgrade works. This amounts to around 31% of total costs.

# 3. Consultation, Engagement and Communication

3.1 Exeter's intention to upgrade its CCTV suite has been under review for some time. Whilst the local police have not been directly consulted over the plans for the upgrade, it meets the PCC's CCTV investment strategy to provide a contribution to monitoring hubs across Devon and Cornwall.

# 4.1 Legal, Management and Equality Implications – Current and Future

The PCC's Chief Executive and Monitoring Officer has advised that the arrangements set out in the proposal meet the requirements of the PCC's CCTV Investment Strategy and the criteria for awarding capital grants.
